

Guide to Curve Master Presser Foot Adapters

The Curve Master Presser Foot comes packaged with 4 universal adapters to allow the Curve Master Presser Foot to adapt to most any sewing machine.

1. Used alone, the Curve Master is a snap-on foot which fits Janome, New Home, and other “snap-on” foot sewing machines. Bernina Artista machines and the Bernina 1008 can use a special Bernina adapter (Adapter #125 or #1008) and become “snap-on” foot machines.
2. Using the “Low Shank Adapter” (furthest right in the photo), adapts the foot to use on Pfaff, Singer Featherweight and Bernina machines. Bernina machines require use of a “Bernina Low Shank adapter” from Bernina in addition to this adapter except as noted above. For Pfaff machines, disengage the dual-feed foot, loosen the large screw on the left side of the presser foot mechanism and remove the metal holder. Replace the metal piece with the low shank adapter and replace the screw. Attach the presser foot to the adapter.
3. Singer Slant-Needle Machines use the adapter with the greatest angle of slant, 2nd from the right.
4. Kenmore Super-High Shank adapter, 3rd from the right, is the tallest of the four adapters.
